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GIVE THANKS

Every year, on the fourth Thursday in November, we celebrate Thanksgiving. It's usually a time that we demonstrate our thanks for family, friends, blessings, prosperity and good health. How many things are you thankful for: health, strength ability to walk, the air you breathe, ability to taste-smell-talk-see-hear, salvation, God's love, peace and hope in Jesus? Anything else? I once read about a woman who was born without legs or arms. She said she was thankful that God allowed her to write many books and songs with a pen in her mouth, now she thanks the Lord daily for the ability to write.

The Bible has many illustrations of thanksgiving; I want to share one of those powerful examples with you. Luke 17:11-19 tells where 10 men with Leprosy heard that Jesus was going around healing the sick and performing miracles. They saw Jesus from far away and shouted, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" When Jesus saw them, He had mercy on them and said, "Go show yourselves to the priest." The Bible says, "...as they went, they were healed." Only one of them stopped, came back and thanked Jesus. Jesus asked him, "Weren't there ten lepers, where are the other nine?" Nonetheless, this Leper was so thankful; he came back to give thanks!

Today, regardless of your circumstances, you should still give thanks to God because you have a lot to be thankful for. The enemy comes to makes people feel hopeless, devalued and insignificant. It is a trick he uses to make you feel worthless because that it is his job - to steal, kill and destroy. But Jesus said, "I have come that you might have life and life more abundantly!" I encourage you to take time every day to give God thanks. 1 Thessalonians 5:18 says, "In everything give thanks, for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you." Even though your situation may not be good, be thankful that God will work it for your good! Romans 8:28 says, "All things work together for good for those who love the Lord."

At times, life's circumstances make it seem as if we're stuck, thus having nothing to be thankful for. But I believe sometimes God allows our lives to be in a holding pattern. When an airplane can't land safely at the airport due to inclement weather or dangerous situations, Air Traffic Control directs the pilot to be in a holding pattern until it is safe to land. A holding pattern is when the airplane is still flying, but to the naked eye from the ground, it looks like the airplane is not moving, but it is moving. Satan will tempt you to feel like you have nothing to be thankful for or that you're not moving or growing, but this could just mean that your life is in a "Holding Pattern." Keep on moving, trusting, dreaming, hoping and believing that "God is able to do exceedingly and abundantly above all that we ask or think." (Eph. 3:20)

I encourage you to always give thanks to God and remember no matter what happens, your life is in His hands. I want to close with the lyrics of a song written by Kirk Franklin that says, "You don't have to worry and don't you be afraid, joy comes in the morning, troubles they don't last always, for there's a friend named Jesus who will wipe your tears away, and if your heart is broken, just lift your hands and say... Oh, I know that I can make it, I know that I can stand, no matter what may come my way, my life is in God's hands. With Jesus I can take it, With Him I know I can stand, no matter what may come my way, my life is in God's hands. So, when your tests and trials, they seem to get you down, and all your friends and loved ones are nowhere to be found, Remember, there's a friend named Jesus, who will wipe your tears away, and if your heart is broken, just lift your hands and say... Oh, I know that I can make it, I know that I can stand, no matter what may come my way, my life is in God's hands."

Take the Thankful Challenge (or 30-Day Challenge): I challenge you to start each day with thinking about 10 things you're thankful for, and every time you pray, thank God for these things before you ask him for anything. In one week, you'll have 70 specific things you're thankful for, and in one month you'll have over 300 things and in one year, you'll have over 3,600 specific things you're thankful for. No matter what, always...give thanks!
