



HOW TO BECOME THE BIGGEST WINNER, PART 1

There's a popular television show called, The Biggest Loser that focused on weight loss. Contestants would go on the show and compete with other people to see who could lose the most weight. I want to talk about how to become the biggest winner. In this

race you are not competing against others, you will be competing against yourself. The Apostle Paul provided us with Hebrews 12:1-2.

In this scripture passage, Paul explains the Christian life by comparing it to an athletic race. The

witnesses he speaks about are the Christians [Heroes] who have died, gone on before us and are cheering us on. They are not spectators, but inspiring examples. The Christian life is pictured as a marathon, rather than a sprint. During that time in history, some Hebrew Christians were tempted to drop out of the contest because of

their persecution. That's why Paul said, "Run with perseverance and patience..." because many Christians today give up and quit too easily. Although you will have trials and problems in life, the goal is to "Fix our eyes on Jesus..." not on our problems. Then, just as a runner should focus on the finish

Hebrews 12:1-2 (KJV)

"Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God."

line, Christians must focus on Jesus, who is the goal and objective of our faith: "The finisher or perfecter of our faith" Jesus is both the start and finish of the race, He is Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end! He is the supreme witness because He has run the race (suffered shame, the crucifixion and resurrection), and has overcome victoriously. 
You may not control all the events that happen to you, but you can decide not to be reduced by them.
