### A New Assessment

January 25, 2017 – I am in a cell two paces by four paces. I feel as if the walls are compressing, daily, about to suffocate me. On the dirty walls of the tiny cell, scribbled by the previous occupant, "DON'T DO DOPE", "JESUS ❤️", "7/12 STOPPED". Three strong statements.

When I was told on the 24th of January 2017 that I would be moved to a different prison I was filled with despair. I mean I was in a comfortable, safe place, making minimum wage, a positive environment and my family close. But who said prison would be comfortable. I was being transferred to an environment that had a reputation of being tough, unpredictable...Lansing Correctional Facility. Anxious, I was wondering how it was going to be; I kept a smile on my face and was hopeful. Three hours shackled on a bus, staring precariously to get a glimpse of the outside world through tiny windows above, a reminder of what freedom looked like.

Upon arrival, ushered into our cells. It is lockdown 23 hours a day, dirty, old looking. My cell at first look was dirty, uninviting, I had no mattress, no bed sheets and I had not taken a shower for quite some time. I did not have my property, not even a toothbrush to brush my teeth. Things were looking bad. I took stock of my confictions, within and without, and decided that first I needed to clean up the cell thoroughly. Afterwards, I sat on the bunk and really looked around at my surroundings and that is when I saw the three messages scribbled on the wall.

I considered them messages, because after reflection, I understood that as dire as my situation looked, something positive could be found anywhere. And to reinforce the message...I was given a new mattress, clean sheets and blankets, and the totality of despair that seemed to envelop and drown me started to dissipate.

### Be That Man

Getting caught up in the way the world thinks can be, and is for many, very frustrating. Feeling powerless you lose heart. As you focus more on the problem instead of the problem solver, you stop praying, you stop reading your Bible regularly. Attending Bible study is "iffy", especially if you're not feeling it. Going to church now is based on how you feel. All of the above are lies from the devil designed to get you to give up hope. The devil wants you to feel helpless and powerless. The devil's tactics aren't new. Jesus is telling us what is going to happen and our course of action to take in order to remain effective. Jesus tells his disciples in John 16:33 "These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world". Remember "The thief, (the devil) cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy... ". (John 10:10) He wants to steal your joy.

I know at the time I've gone through something it has felt like the weight of the world was on me. Guess what though? The situation passed. I endured it and was strengthened by it. Was it pleasant? No! But I had to go through the fire though. Fire purifies and strengthens you. Do any of you need to be purified or strengthened? Think about it. Whatever the problem, God is working it out if we continue to trust Him, rely on him, and cry out to Him. He's an on time God! After all your years of faithful training, you've been summoned into service for such a time as this to put your training into action. You've been called to the front of the battle. You will take back your family, community, and the country. As the Lord told Joshua in Chapter 1:9, "Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed; for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest." For the best results...follow the instructions.

In reading through the Book of Isaiah the Holy Spirit showed me that our nation is corrupt and evil. Men's hearts have become foolish and hardened, desiring nothing to do with anything Godly. Prison can be a barrier to serving God, but only if you let it. In the words of John F. Kennedy, "Ask not what your country can do for you, but what you can do for your country?" What can you do in service to the Lord in your home, in your community, in church, on your job, and in society as a whole? Ask God to show you where you'll be effective, empowered by Him. Wherever the Lord wants to use me it is my reasonable service. This isn't something that I should consider or is optional. Romans 12:1 leaves no doubt about this. Paul says "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service."

Since we're told that we're more than conquerors, I want to challenge every confessing Christian man to declare that you Be That Man who will study to show yourself approved unto God, a workman that needed not be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of God" (II Timothy 2:15). I challenge you to Be That Man who will not surrender to the social pressures of the world. "And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God" (Romans 12:2). I challenge you to Be That Man by setting yourself apart from the chaos and confusion.

 I CHALLENGE YOU TO BE THAT MAN WHO SAYS "YES! I CAN", AND STRIVE TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE. YOU CAN DO ALL THINGS THROUGH CHRIST WHICH STRENGTHENS YOU." (PHILIPPIANS 4:13)  
 I CHALLENGE YOU TO BE THAT MAN WHO STANDS FOR TRUTH AND RIGHTEOUSNESS. ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE THROUGH CHRIST.

This is possible because "For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them" (Ephesians 2:10). When you see a need, remember you are That Man. When no one else will go remember you are That Man.

### The Lawbreaker Who Became a Lawyer



Before he became a lawyer and prolific supporter of prisoner rights, Daniel Manville spent three years and four months in the slammer for manslaughter. Manville continued to study while incarcerated and eventually earned two college degrees during his sentence. He became enamored with the legal profession and went to law school right after his parole.

He finally passed the bar exams in Michigan and Washington, DC after waiting many years to be approved by the respective boards. Afterwards, Manville worked tirelessly to improve the prison system and represented various inmates and prison guards in civil cases. Nowadays, Manville teaches law at Michigan State University, where he hopes the insights he shares with students inspire them to someday help improve the system as well.
